

## Sole Proprietorship Account Registration Requirements

<u>Province</u>	<u>Registration Requirements</u>
<b>Alberta</b> <b>British Columbia</b> <b>Northwest Territories</b> <b>Nunavut</b> <b>Yukon</b>	<p>The registration of a Trade Name is required if the business is engaged in:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Trading (buying and selling of goods);</li> <li>• Manufacturing; or</li> <li>• Mining purposes</li> </ul>
<b>Manitoba</b>	<p>The registration of a Trade Name is required for anyone who carries on business under a business name.</p> <p><b>Exception</b> - Registration not required if:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• It is a profession which is regulated by a governing body established under provincial legislation (e.g. doctor, lawyer, etc.)</li> </ul>
<b>New Brunswick</b>	<p>The registration of a Trade Name is required if the business is engaged in:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Trading (buying and selling of goods);</li> <li>• Manufacturing; or</li> <li>• Mining purposes</li> </ul>
<b>Newfoundland &amp; Labrador</b>	<p>No registration requirement.</p>
<b>Nova Scotia</b>	<p>The registration of a Trade Name is required.</p> <p>Exception - Registration not required if the business is engaged</p>

	<p>in:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• farming or fishing</li> </ul>
<b>Ontario</b>	The registration of a Trade Name is required for anyone who carries on business under a business name.
<b>Prince Edward Island</b>	The registration of a Trade Name is required.
<b>Quebec</b>	<p>The registration of a Trade Name is required.</p> <p><b>Exception:</b> If the business name includes the sole proprietor's given name and surname it is not required. (Example: John Doe Garage).</p>
<b>Saskatchewan</b>	<p>The registration of a Trade Name is required for anyone who carries on business under a business name.</p> <p><b>Exception - Registration not required if:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• It is a profession which is regulated by a governing body established under provincial legislation (e.g. doctor, lawyer, etc.)</li> <li>• If the business is the primary production of agricultural products</li> </ul>
